This bar is made with cocoa from the farmer cooperatives CONACADO, in the Dominican Republic, and CACVRA, in Peru, the fairly traded organic sugar comes from cooperatives in Paraguay and Costa Rica, and the milk for this bar comes from Organic Valley, a cooperative of family farmers in the U.S.

Organic Dark Chocolate with Almonds (55% cocoa) \$4.00/bar

Try this bar to experience the mouth-watering combination of rich dark chocolate with chunks of organic almonds. This bar is made with cocoa from the farmer cooperatives CONACADO, in the Dominican Republic, and CACVRA, in Peru, and the fairly traded organic sugar comes from cooperatives in Paraguay and Costa Rica.
